## Lieutenant General John Miller Joins the CellExchange Advisory Board

Prior to retiring from the military, LTG Miller spent most of his career commanding line units, developing new war fighting concepts and requirements, and in teaching, training and leading soldiers and officers in a variety of assignments in field commands in Europe, the United States and the Republic of Vietnam, on the Army Staff, and in the US Army's Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC). He served as Deputy Commanding General (Futures), TRADOC, from July 1995 - Aug 1997 where he integrated the work of multiple agencies for the Army's Digital Battlefield experiments and the development and approval of the Army's first Distance Learning Master Plan.

Earlier, he served as the Commandant (President) of the US Army's Command and General Staff College, a mid-career professional college accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Universities and by the Joint Chiefs of Staff that provides professional education to US Military Officers from all services and from 65 foreign countries. He was also responsible for the Army's Battle Command Battle Laboratory, the National Simulation Center and 11 other Army Schools providing training and education for Commissioned and Non-Commissioned Officers.

LTG Miller was also Chair of the Board on Army Science and Technology, National Research Council, and National Academies. He was a DoD delegate to Harvard's Kennedy School of Government exchange program with the People's Liberation Army, China.

LTG Miller holds a Bachelor's of Science in Mathematics from the Southwest Missouri State University, and a Master's degree in Operations Research from Georgia Institute of Technology. He also attended the US Army War College Executive Development Program at Yale University.
